

# COMMERCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY AND FILMING



The Trustees and Volunteers of Bannockburn House thank you for your interest in our 17<sup>th</sup> Century property with links to many exciting events in Scottish history.

The house is now owned by the local community and will be conserved and used for the enjoyment and benefit of future generations. It is a listed building which means that it is culturally significant and must be kept safe from damage. It also ensures that its repair, development, and use will be sympathetic and appropriate to its history and placement in the landscape.

Conserving and maintaining the building, and developing it into a central feature of our community will cost a large amount. Charging a fee for commercial and professional photography is one way of raising the money we will need.

**We welcome photographers and film makers to Bannockburn House provided their work and the uses it is put to are consistent with our aims, in keeping with our brand, and will not damage the house, its contents, or grounds.**

Commercial and professional photography (including tripod use) is not allowed in Bannockburn House or grounds without advance negotiation and written permission. Also, we ask that the use of tripods with spikes are not used within the house due to possible damage to the property.

We will ask you to complete an application form and contact you to arrange a site meeting to discuss your proposal. You will be asked to conduct a risk assessment, provide evidence that you hold appropriate insurances, and to sign a contract covering the fee and other terms and conditions agreed.
